

## FLOWER POWER

Make your mum's day by surprising her with these pretty paper flowers.

### WHAT YOU NEED

- Serviettes of different colours
- Chenille stems (also known as pipe cleaners, from art shops)
- Scissors and glue
- Pencil

### DIRECTIONS

- 1 To make the petals, fold the serviettes in the style of a *kacang puteh* holder or a restaurant napkin. Flatten them.
- 2 Take the bottom half and cut a semi-circle, so that the cut-out resembles an ice cream cone. Open the serviettes to see the stack of petals created.
- 3 Make a hole in the middle of the petals for the chenille stems to go through. Twist the stem at the top of the petals around a pencil to secure it.
- 4 Make a bunch of flowers this way and tie them together before handing them over to mummy dearest.
