

SPINNING WHEELS

Here's a simple craft project that you can have fun playing with afterwards. You can use many different kinds of paper to make colourful combinations. Pin these spinning wheels on the wall to decorate your room or place them in a vase and watch them spin when the wind blows.

WHAT YOU NEED

- Paper squares (coloured paper, lined paper, foil or wrapping paper)
- Scissors
- Stick pins
- Eraser or cork
- Skewers

WHAT TO DO

1. Place one paper square on top of another.
2. Fold the paper from corner to corner diagonally, both ways.
3. On all four sides, cut along the fold 1/3 of the way to the centre.
4. Take every alternate corner of the square and fold it to the centre.
5. Stick a pin through the centre into an eraser or cork.
6. Stick the skewer into the cork or eraser as a handle.
7. Loosen the pin so that the paper can spin freely. You may need to spin it a few times to loosen it up.
