

LEAF IMPRINTS

Leaves come in lots of shapes and sizes. The palm leaf is big enough to sit on, while the leaf of the clover fits on your fingertip. The leaves of the pine tree look like needles and in fact are called pine needles.

Some leaves have jagged edges and some are straight and smooth. Have a look around your home and see what different leaves you can see. Here's a fun project that makes a pretty nice room decoration too.



What to do:

1. Roll out the clay.
2. Press one leaf into the clay and then carefully remove it.
3. Press the other leaf into the clay so that it doesn't overlap onto the other print.
4. Remove the leaf.
5. Poke a hole into the top of your piece of clay so that you can hang it up.
6. Let it dry overnight.
7. Paint it and hang it up.

What you need:

- Paper clay
- Two different leaves
- Skewer
- Wire or string
- Paint
