**Poor:** to not have much of something, usually money.

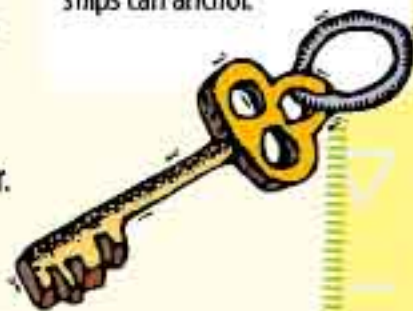
**Pour:** to move something from one container over to another.
