

HANGING MOBILE

A mobile is like a sculpture that's hung in mid-air. When the wind blows, the different parts of the mobile move about.

This month, why not decorate your room with a cute mobile! The best part is, you can choose your own design. Get your parents to help you with the more difficult parts.

What you need:

Sheet of thin foam
Wire
Needle
Foam balls (or other shapes that you like)
Paint
Fishing line

(You can get all these at art supply shops.)



What to do:

1. Find a design or shape you like. We chose cats, but you can also try alphabets, shapes and more. Ask a parent to help you enlarge it on a photocopier if it's too small.
2. Cut out the design and place it on a piece of thin foam. Trace the shape and then cut it out (you may need a parent's help).
3. Paint the foam balls in different colours.
4. Get your mum or dad to help you tie the fishing line to the wire and the shapes to form a mobile.
5. Hang it from the ceiling. Doesn't it look like the cats are chasing the balls?
